




ONE BRAIN, ONE COMPUTER


This computer talks in all languages, it's your personal interpreter and mediator – your bodyguard, your teacher and your friend.

In this campaign, we are presenting two movies, in a continuing experience that completes the idea of one brain, one computer.






It's an eye-catcher movie that draws people to watch it, due to its very surreal powerful image.


